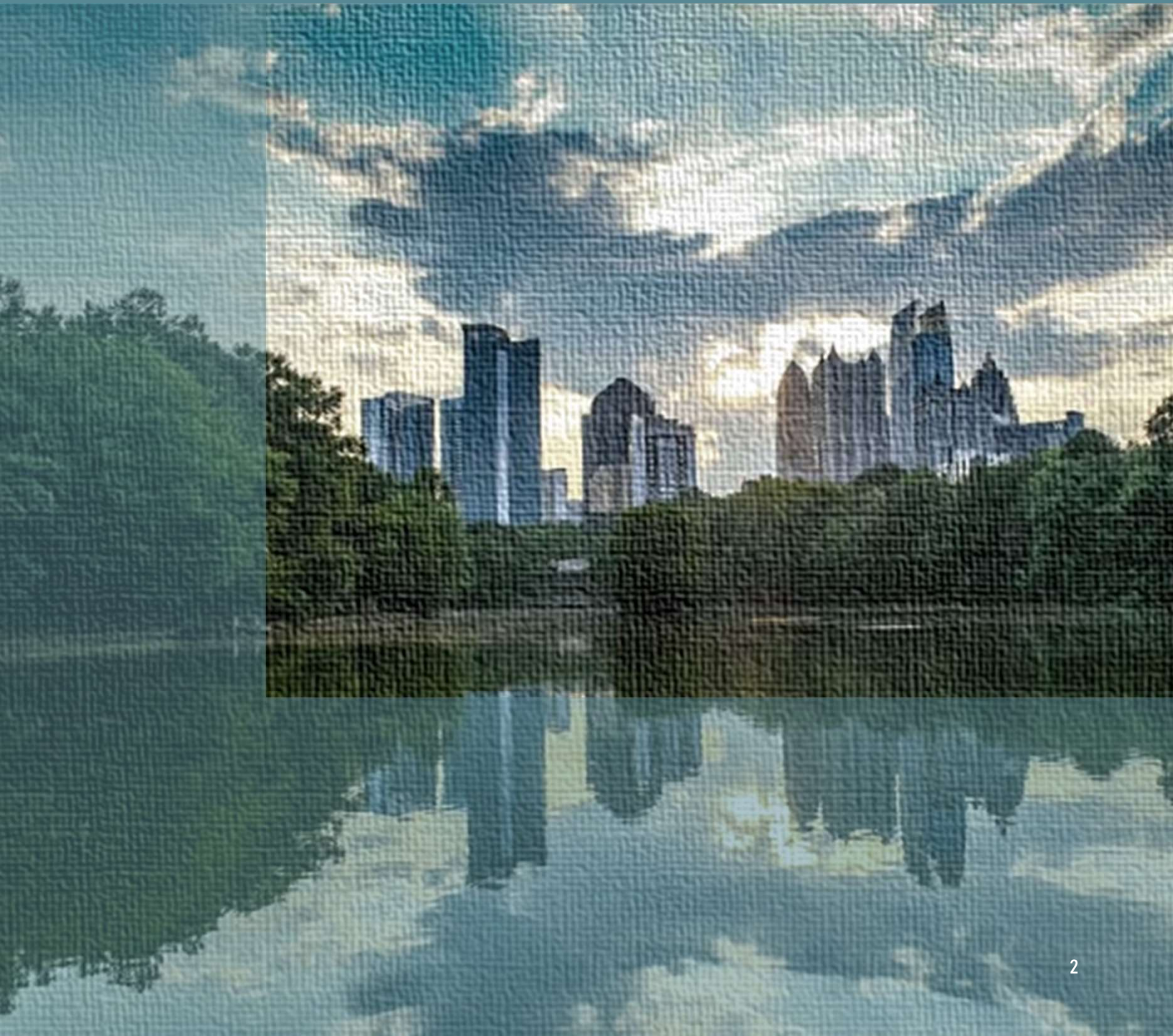

The Atlanta Cancer Care Foundation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, serving cancer patients and their loved ones in the 17 county Metro Atlanta area.



“You have cancer.” When a physician tells someone those three words, it will forever change that person’s life. Among the many thoughts that people think about is how will (we) be able to live with our reduced income. What will happen if we cannot pay our rent? Who will help with the bills?

For 1,636 Metro Atlanta cancer patients, the Atlanta Cancer Care Foundation (ACCF) relieved some of the financial stress associated with their living expenses. ACCF helps with rent payments, gas, groceries, and utilities.

For over 24 years, the Atlanta Cancer Care Foundation has offered indispensable financial assistance to over 12,000 Metro Atlanta cancer patients who require support in managing the frequently overwhelming expenses associated with their illness and treatment. ACCF has provided these patients with over Four Million dollars in assistance with essential living expenses.

Beyond the financial aid, ACCF grants serve as a poignant reminder to patients and their families that they are not alone. They highlight the collective efforts of individuals, foundations, and corporations in their community who extend their support, courage, hope, and resilience to help combat their disease.

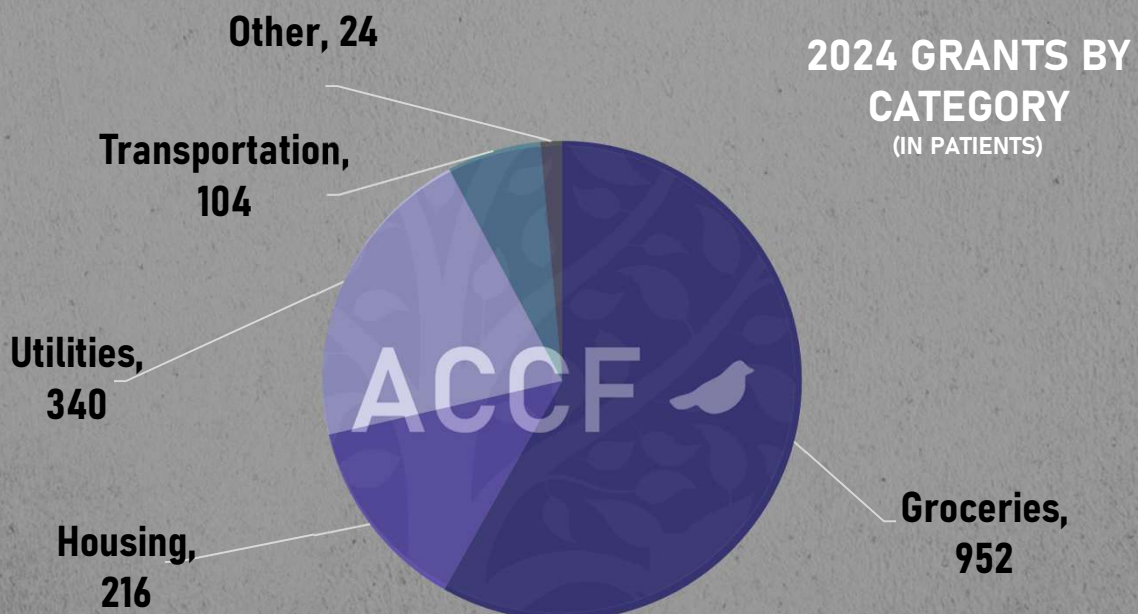

ACCF GRANTS HELP PATIENTS PAY FOR VITAL SERVICES

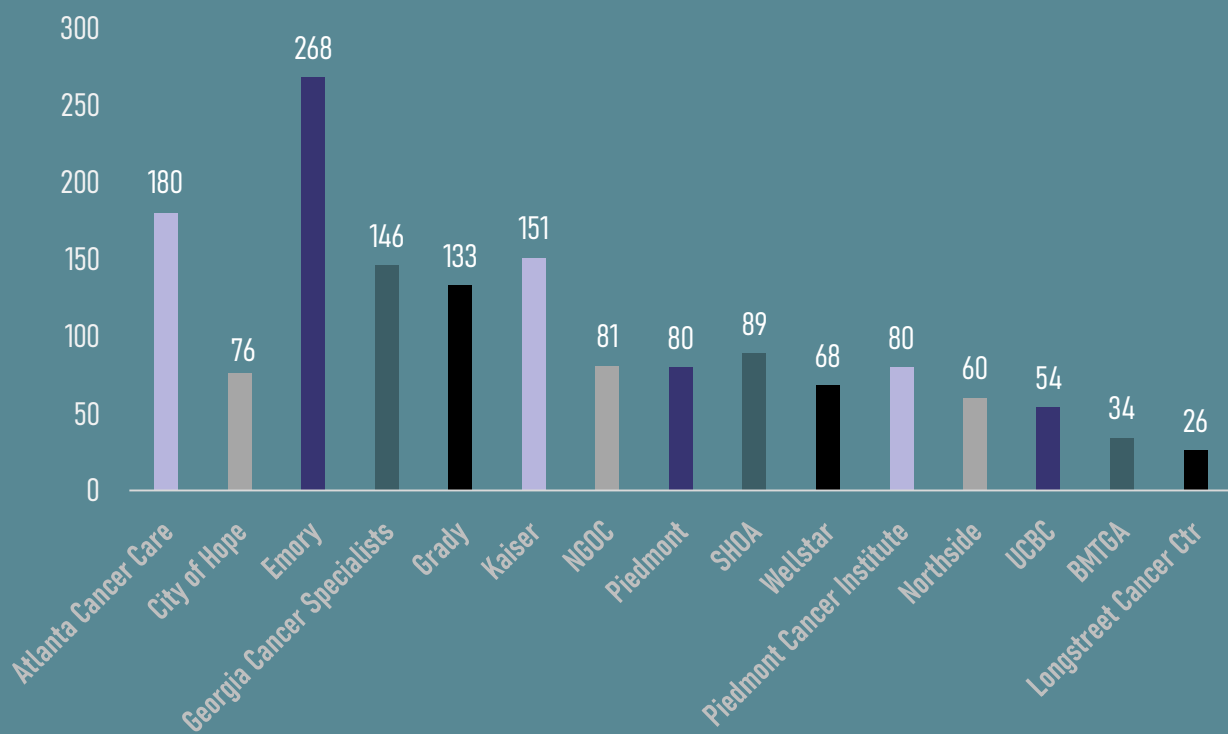


ACCF grants are also a great reminder to patients that they are not alone in their battle against cancer.
