The Atlanta Cancer Care Foundation is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization, serving cancer patients and their loved ones in the 17 county Metro Atlanta area.



**I believe in miracles. I see them every day.** Especially when people choose to act together. Food drives, coat collections, and school-supply donations—simple acts of compassion—are everyday miracles powered by community.

In 2025, I witnessed more than 1,750 such miracles through the Atlanta Cancer Care Foundation. Together, we provided vital financial assistance to Metro Atlanta cancer patients facing overwhelming challenges. We helped families stay housed, kept electricity, natural gas, and water running, supported transportation to treatment, and eased the burden of daily living expenses. We also helped with food, distributing **\$135,000 in Kroger gift cards** and over **\$122,000 in Walmart gift cards** to patients fighting this terrible disease.

None of this would have been possible without the generosity of our donors, friends, and partners. Because of their support, patients did not have to choose between rent and medicine or between paying a utility bill and getting to treatment. More than 1,000 families were able to buy groceries during an unimaginably difficult time.

For nearly 25 years, ACCF has provided **\$4.4 million** in indispensable financial assistance to more than **15,000 Metro Atlanta cancer patients**. Beyond the financial help, each grant reminds patients and their families that they are not alone. It reflects a community of individuals, foundations, and corporations standing with them—offering strength, hope, and resilience in the fight against cancer.

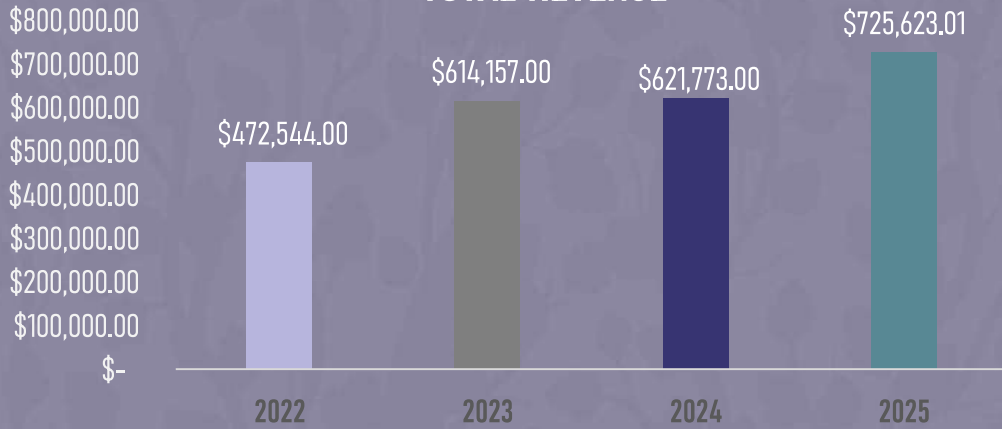

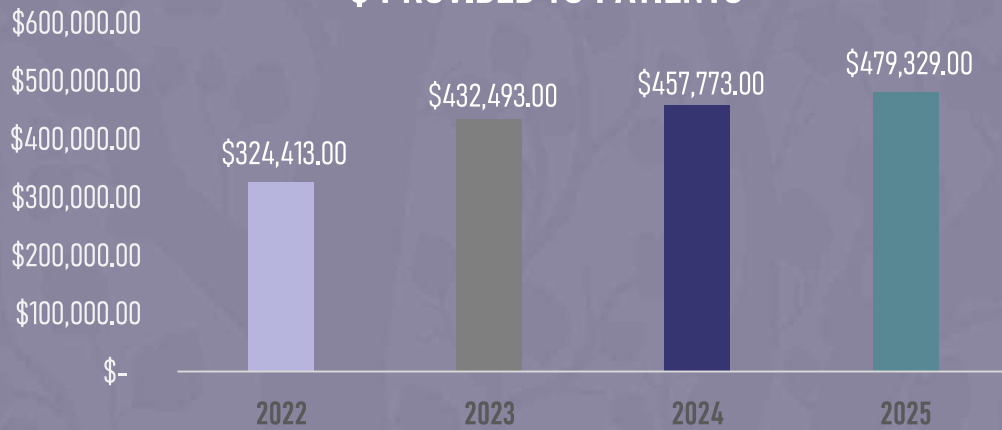

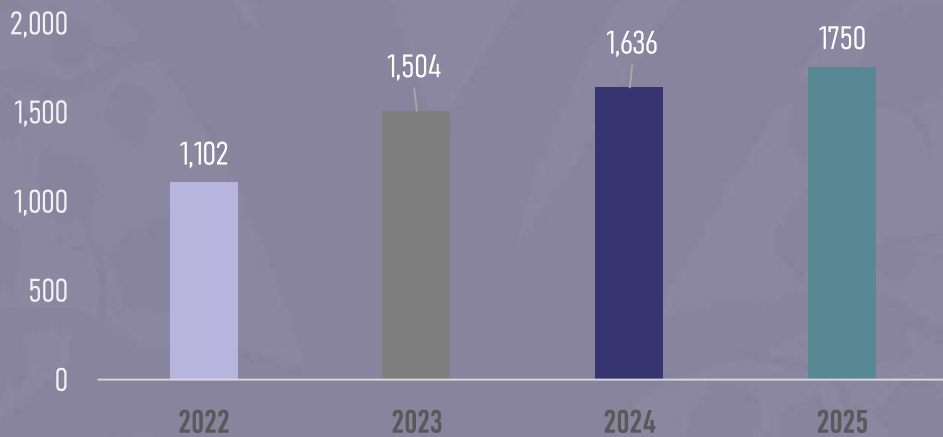
## TOTAL REVENUE



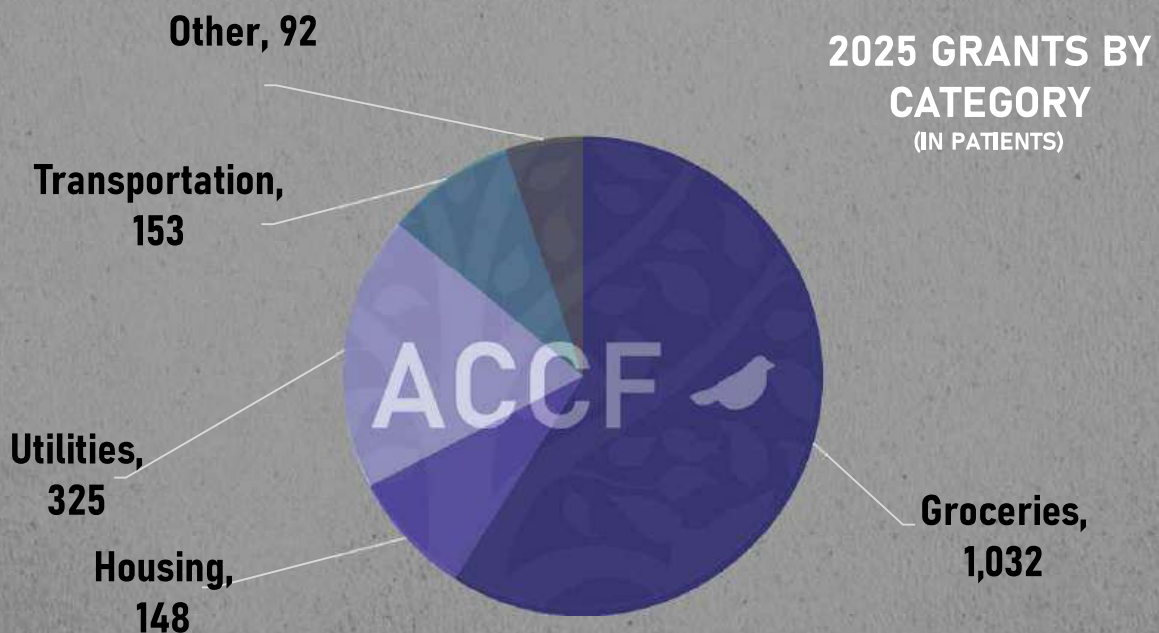
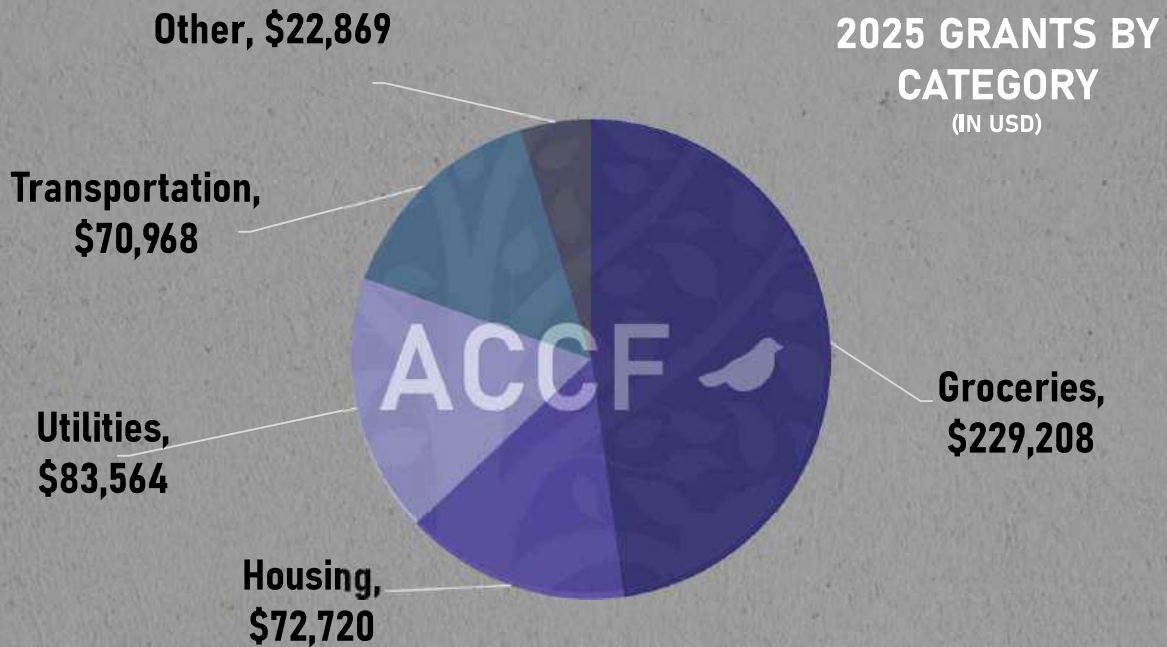

# ACCF GRANTS HELP PATIENTS PAY FOR VITAL SERVICES

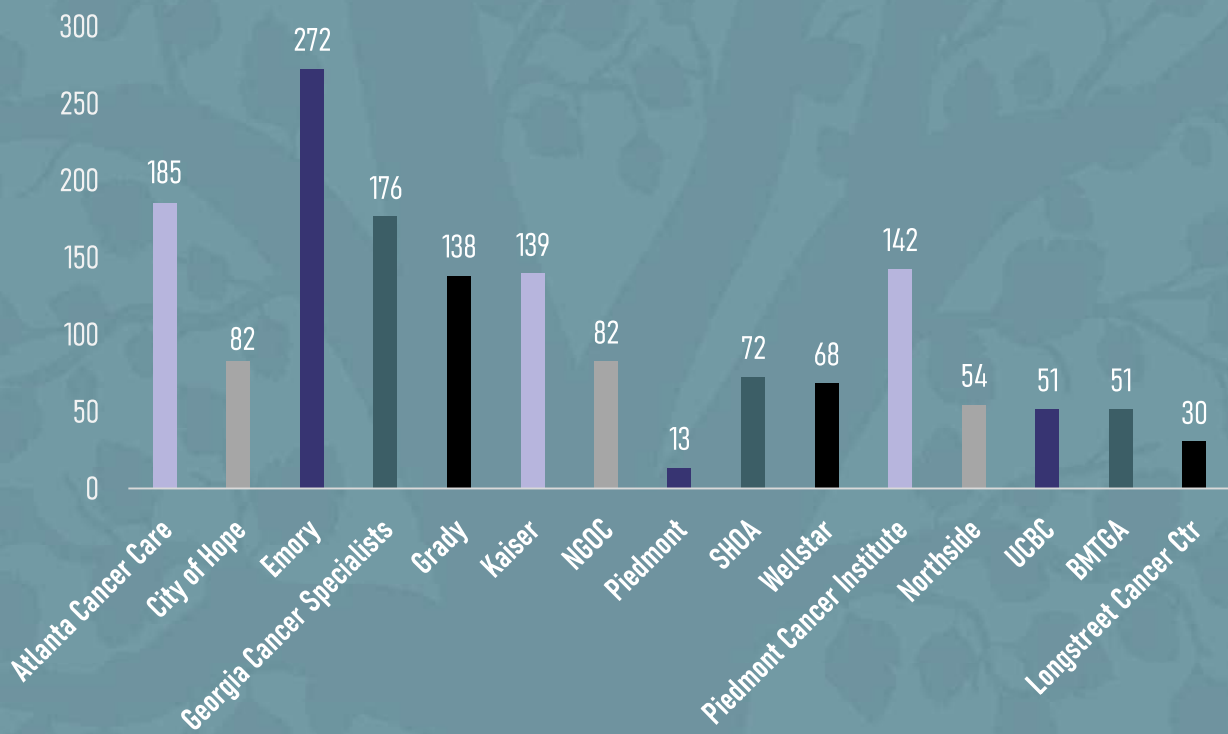


ACCF grants are also a reminder to patients that **they are not alone** in their battle against cancer.
